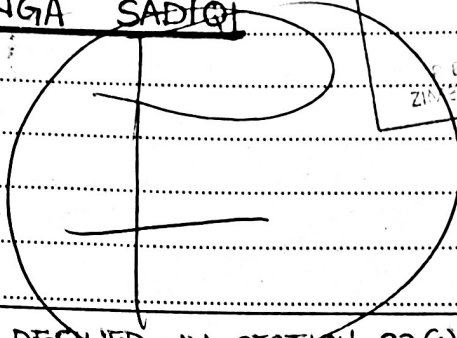

Count 1

KIDNAPPING AS DEFINED IN SECTION 93(1)(b)(ii) OF THE CRIMINAL LAW [CODIFICATION AND REFORM] ACT CHAPTER 9:23

In that on the 26th day of March 2020 at around 1415 hours, Spar Supermarket, Parktown parking space, Waterfalls, Harare, Frank Buyanga Saqidi, who is the father but not being the lawful custodian of a child, namely, Daniel Alexander Buyanga Saqidi detained and kept Daniel Alexander Buyanga Saqidi, intending to deprive Chantelle Muteswa the lawful custodian of her control over Daniel Alexander Buyanga Saqidi or realising that there was a real risk or possibility that such deprivation might result.

Count 2

ROBBERY AS DEFINED IN SECTION 126(1)(a) OF THE CRIMINAL LAW (CODIFICATION AND REFORM) ACT CHAPTER 9:23

In that on the 26th of March 2020 and at Spar Supermarket Parktown parking space Waterfalls, Harare Frank Buyanga Saqidi unlawfully and intentionally used violence against Chantelle Muteswa in order to steal her handbag which contained US\$2000-00 cash.

Count 3

CONTEMPT OF COURT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 182(2)(e) OF THE
CRIMINAL LAW (CODIFICATION AND REFORM) ACT CHAPTER 9:23

In that on the 17th of April 2020, Frank **Buyanga Saqidi** by omission, impaired the dignity, reputation or authority of a court by knowingly contravening or failing to comply with the High Court of Zimbabwe Order given during or in respect of judicial proceedings on case number HC2149/20 compelling him to release a minor child Daniel Alexander **Buyanga Saqidi** and hand him at Waterfalls Police Station within 24 hours of the order

OUTLINE OF THE STATE CASE

Count 1

1. The complainant is Chantelle Tatenda **Muteswa** a female aged 31 years. She resides at House Number 280 Woodlands, Waterfalls, Harare and is employed at Telesade Enterprise Eastlea, Harare.
2. The accused person Frank Buyanga **Sadiqi** is a male adult residing at house number 3 Uplands Close, Highlands, Harare.
3. The accused and the complainant sired a child together (Daniel Alexander **Sadiqi** born on 14 August 2014) before their union broke down.
4. A legal wrangle over the custody of the child then ensued which on 29 May 2019 resulted in a court order which granted the custody of the child to the complainant.
5. The accused appealed to the High Court and a joint guardianship and joint custody of the child was granted on 23 March 2020. However, the High Court order directed that the parties should first have a Government Social worker appointed by the Registrar of the High Court to prepare and present a report within 30 days of the order for a final order to be made regarding the full terms of the joint custody.
6. On 26 March 2020 and at around 1415 hours the complainant who was in the company of her mother Judith **Muteswa**, and her five year old son Daniel Alexander **Sadiqi**, parked her vehicle at Spar supermarket, parking space, Parktown, Waterfalls, Harare.
7. After a while the complainant tried to start her motor vehicle but however the engine failed. The complainant and her mother

alighted from the vehicle to open the bonnet, leaving her son seated at the back seat.

8. The accused person who was in the company of three other males [NFPK] suddenly parked a South African registered open truck behind complainant's vehicle. The accused and two of his accomplices who were in black suits approached the complainant's vehicle and the accused opened the back door of the vehicle. He forcibly took out Daniel Alexander **Sadiqi** whilst his accomplices were restraining the complainant and her mother from rescuing the child from the accused by assaulting them with fists all over their bodies.
9. The accused persons then sped off at high speed.
10. The accused had no right whatsoever to act in the manner he did.

Count 2

1. The complainant is as per count 1.
2. The accused person is as per count 1.
3. On 26 March 2020 and at around 1430 hours, whilst the complainant was wrestling with the accused's accomplices, (as per count 1) the accused took the complainant's handbag which contained US\$2 000-00 and cosmetics.
4. The accused person then sped off at high speed
5. The accused had no right whatsoever to act in the manner he did.

Count 3

1. The complainant is the State.
2. The accused person is as per count 1.
3. On 7 April 2020 an application was made at the High Court over the custodianship and the return of the child (as per count 1) to his mother.

4. On 16 April 2020, a ruling was made at the High Court and the accused was ordered to return the child [Daniel Alexander Buyanga **Sadiqi**] to ZRP Waterfalls Police within 24 hours from the time of the ruling.
5. The accused failed to comply with the court ruling.
6. Accused acted unlawfully.

NAME : CHANTELE MUTESWA NR 63-2375575-S-63

STATES

1. I am a female adult aged 31 years, residing at House Number 280 Woodlands Waterfalls, Harare. I am employed at Telesade Enterprise Eastlea , Harare. I am contactable on **0784 153 313**.
2. I know the accused persons Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** and Killian **Kapfidze** not only in connection with this case but Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** is the father of my child Daniel Alexander **Buyanga Sadiqi** who is 5 years old and Killian **Kapfidze** is his personal driver, whereas I do not know the identity of the third male accused person.
3. I recall on the 26th of March 2020 at around 1415 hours I was in the company of my mother Judith **Muteswa** and my son Daniel Alexander **Buyanga Sadiqi**. I had parked my motor vehicle Honda fit white in colour registration numbers **AEQ 1677** at Spar Parktown parking space Waterfalls, Harare as I wanted to buy something in the shop.
4. I disembarked from my vehicle and went inside Spar Supermarket and did my shopping then came back to my vehicle. I placed my grocery at the back passenger seat where my son was seated. I embarked into my vehicle and I tried to switch on the car but it failed since it has a terminal problem.
5. I opened the bonnet and requested my mother to go the bonnet to press the battery terminals so that I could I switch on the car engine. When I was in the process of switching on the engine I noted at the back seat a hand with a blue latex glove which was inserted through the left back window opening the door. That is when I realised that it was the first accused Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** opening the left passenger door where my child was seated. The accused Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** took my child forcefully whilst his other accomplice Killian **Kapfidze** was shielding Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** and Killian **Kapfidze** proceeded to place an unidentified small firearm on the seat where my child was seated.

6. I then disembarked from my vehicle trying to get my child and noted that the accused person Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** was already in his motor vehicle inscribed Raider, a pickup truck, white in colour with South African registration plates. The accused Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** was calling my child saying, "**Danny come**", "**Danny com**". In the process I also managed to take note of another tall male adult whom I cannot identify but I had seen him several times before at my child's school in the company of Killian **Kapfidze** he was standing at Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** vehicle.
7. Killian **Kapfidze** tussled with me and my mother so that we could not get my child Daniel Alexander **Buyanga Sadiqi**. In the process the accused person Killian **Kapfidze** was also striking me several times using fists all over my body and at the same time doing the same to my mother.
8. The accused persons managed to take my child and they drove off from where I was parked using their vehicle and at high speed. I then returned to my vehicle and discovered that hand bag which was at the back seat and which contained my cash US \$ 2000-00 and cosmetics had been stolen.
9. That is all I can say at this moment in connection with this case.

States:

1. I am a female adult aged 55 years residing at house number 280 Woodlands, Waterfalls, Harare. I am not employed and am contactable on mobile number **0772 307 284**.

2. I know the accused person Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** not only in connection with this case but same is the father of Daniel Alexander **Buyanga Sadiqi** and I do not know the other three accused persons.

3. On 26 March 2020 and at around 1400 hours I was in the company of my daughter, Chantelle **Muteswa** and her five year old son, Daniel Alexander **Buyanga Sadiqi** heading home from town. We passed through Parktown shopping centre, Waterfalls, Harare where I wanted to collect my assignments which were being typed at the shopping centre. My daughter was driving a Honda Fit, white in colour on registration numbers **AEQ 1677**.

4. I alighted from the vehicle proceeding to collect my typed assignments leaving my daughter and her son seated in the motor vehicle. The person who was typing my assignments then stated that she did not have change and also that she had not printed them. I then advised her that I would collect them after buying something from Spar Parktown, Waterfalls, Harare.

5. I then went back to the vehicle where my daughter and grandson were. My daughter then disembarked from the vehicle and went into Spar Parktown, Waterfalls, Harare and bought some groceries leaving me and her son seated in the motor vehicle. My grandson was seated in the middle of the vehicle on the back seat while I was seated on the front passenger's seat.

6. My daughter then came back from the shop and she handed me some groceries which she had bought. Daniel Alexander **Buyanga Sadiqi** then stated that his mother had bought him his favourite Rasberry drink and he asked me if he could read the container of the drink. I handed it over to him.

7. My daughter then started the vehicle but the engine failed. I then disembarked from the vehicle and told her to open the bonnet so that I could check with the battery since it had a loose connection. She tried the second time but it was to no avail. On the third attempt the engine started.

passenger door. I then noticed that another tall, medium built and brown in complexion male adult also putting on a black suit who had his head and body slightly inside the vehicle through the back door of the vehicle pulling my grandson out of the vehicle.

9. I tried to run and rescue my grandson but the person standing on the front passenger door then blocked me and a fight ensued. The person who had grabbed the child ran towards a parked 4x4 Toyota Raider, white in colour with South African registration numbers inscribed "**Raider**" in black letters just above the rear tyres.

10. I continued wrestling the accused person until the time that he wanted to get into the Toyota Raider. When we got to the Toyota Raider I saw the accused Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** seated on left rear seat of the vehicle while the driver was seated on his seat. I called out saying, "**Frank Buyanga Sadiqi has kidnapped the child**". Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi** called out the name of his son saying, "**Danny come, come Danny**".

11. At that moment the person whom I was wrestling with struck me once with his elbow on my face and he turned facing me. I also saw that he had a gun by his waist. I realised that it was **Killian** [NFPK] one of Frank **Buyanga Sadiqi's** bodyguards. I then grabbed **Killian** by the collar of his jacket from the back to stop him from getting on to the vehicle.

12. The driver of the vehicle then got it in motion whilst I was holding **Killian** by his jacket and running on foot. I fell down as the vehicle was increasing its speed. I sustained lacerations on my right palm, right arm, right shoulder, right hip, right knee, back on the right side and bruises on the left thigh. I got back to our Honda Fit and we tried to give chase but it was to no avail. I called my husband Lawrence **Muteswa** and advised him what had transpired.

13. We then proceeded to ZRP Waterfalls to make a report.

14. To date [02/04/2020], I have not yet established the whereabouts of the child.

15. That is all I can say in connection with this case.

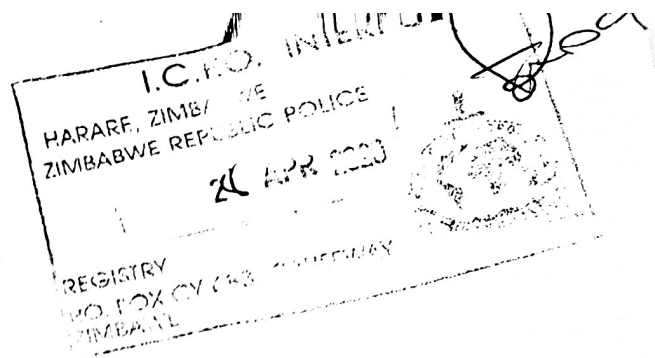



Appended hereto is an INTERPOL Red Notice publication dated 18 May 2020 in respect of the Zimbabwean fugitive Frank Tawanda Buyanga alias Sadiqi in connection with above subject matter.

The accused and the complainant, Chantelle Muteswa sired a child born on 14 August 2014 before their union broke down.

The legal wrangle over the custody of the child ensued which resulted in a court order being issued on 29 May 2019 granting the custody of the child to the complainant.

On 26 March 2020 the accused person in the company of his two unidentified accomplices approached the complainant at Spar Parktown Shopping Centre and forcibly took the child. He also violently grabbed the complainant's handbag containing USD\$2000-00 and sped off. A report was made to the Police.

On 17 April 2020, the fugitive failed to comply with a High Court Order given in respect to judicial proceedings on case number HC2149/20 compelling him to release a minor child Daniel Alexander Buyanga Sadiqi.

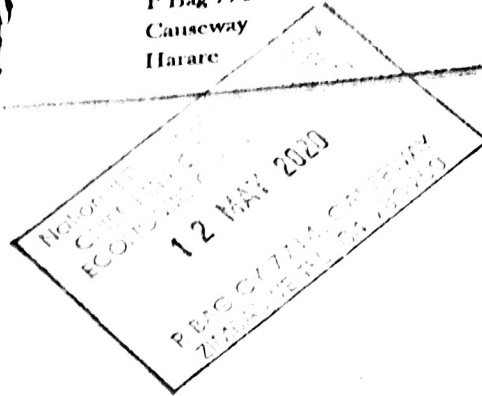
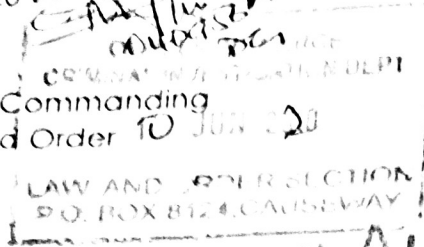

COURT ONE (1)

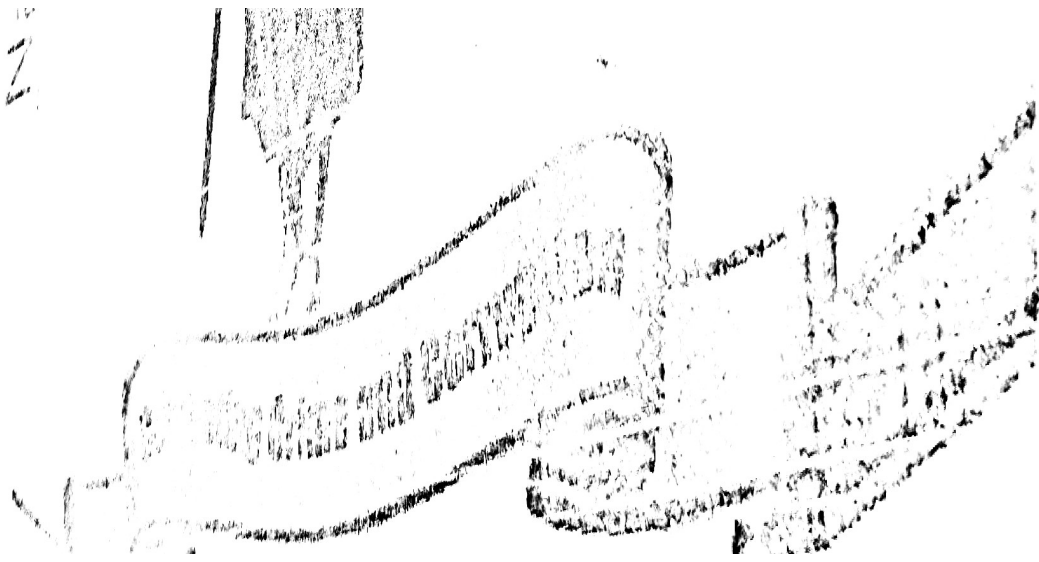
The subject is charged with kidnapping, as defined in Section 93 (1)(b) (ii) of the Criminal Law (Codification and Reform) Act Chapter 9:23. In that on the 26th March 2020 and at Spar Supermarket, Parktown, Waterfalls Harare the subject unlawfully detained and kept a child namely Daniel Alexander Buyanga Saqidi intending to deprive Chantelle Muteswa, the child's lawful custodian of her control over the child.

COURT TWO (2)

The subject is charged with Robbery as defined in section 126(1)(a) of the Criminal Law (Codification and Reform) Act Chapter 9:23; in that on the 26th March 2020 and at Spar Supermarket Parktown, Waterfalls, Harare, the subject unlawfully and intentionally used violence or threats against Chantelle Muteswa in order to induce Chantelle Muteswa to relinquish control over her handbag which contained US \$2000-00.

COURT THREE (3)

The subject is charged with Contempt of Court as defined in section 182 (2) (e) of the Criminal Law (Codification and Reform) Act, Chapter 9:23; in that



the subject by omission impaired the dignity, reputation or authority of a court, knowingly contravened, or failed to comply with a High Court of Zimbabwe order in case number HC 2149/2020 which compelled the subject to release a minor child, namely Daniel Alexander Buyanga Saqidi and hand him at Waterfalls Police Station within twenty-four (24) hours of the order.
